Subdivision improvements: Some of you already noticed the new street and neighborhood signs. They were installed recently around the subdivision for an improved curb appeal of our streets and are easier to read too. The original scope includes landscaping along the street corners with McKnight, however due to the upcoming construction of the sidewalk, similar to Lay Rd that should take place next year, the trustees decided to postpone that part of the scope until the construction is over.
